

# Sight Word Activities

1. Cut out flash cards. Say each word and have your child repeat it while looking at the word.
2. Have your child use the word in a sentence. If your child cannot think of a sentence you can say a sentence and ask if the word is used correctly, but say it correctly immediately.
3. After you have gone through the flash cards several times saying each word and having your child repeat, then have your child read the flash cards. Repeat each word after your child. If your child hesitates or mispronounces, say it correctly immediately.
4. Place the flash cards face up. Have your child point to the ones he/she knows. As your child reads each word, turn the card face down. When all cards are face down have your child turn them up one by one as they are read.
5. Place cards face down. Take turns turning up a card and reading it. If your child reads it correctly, keep it and add up points per card!
6. Keep two envelopes: "Words I am learning" and "Words I know"!
7. When your child knows the words fairly well, time your child to see how many seconds it takes. Have your child try to beat their time!
